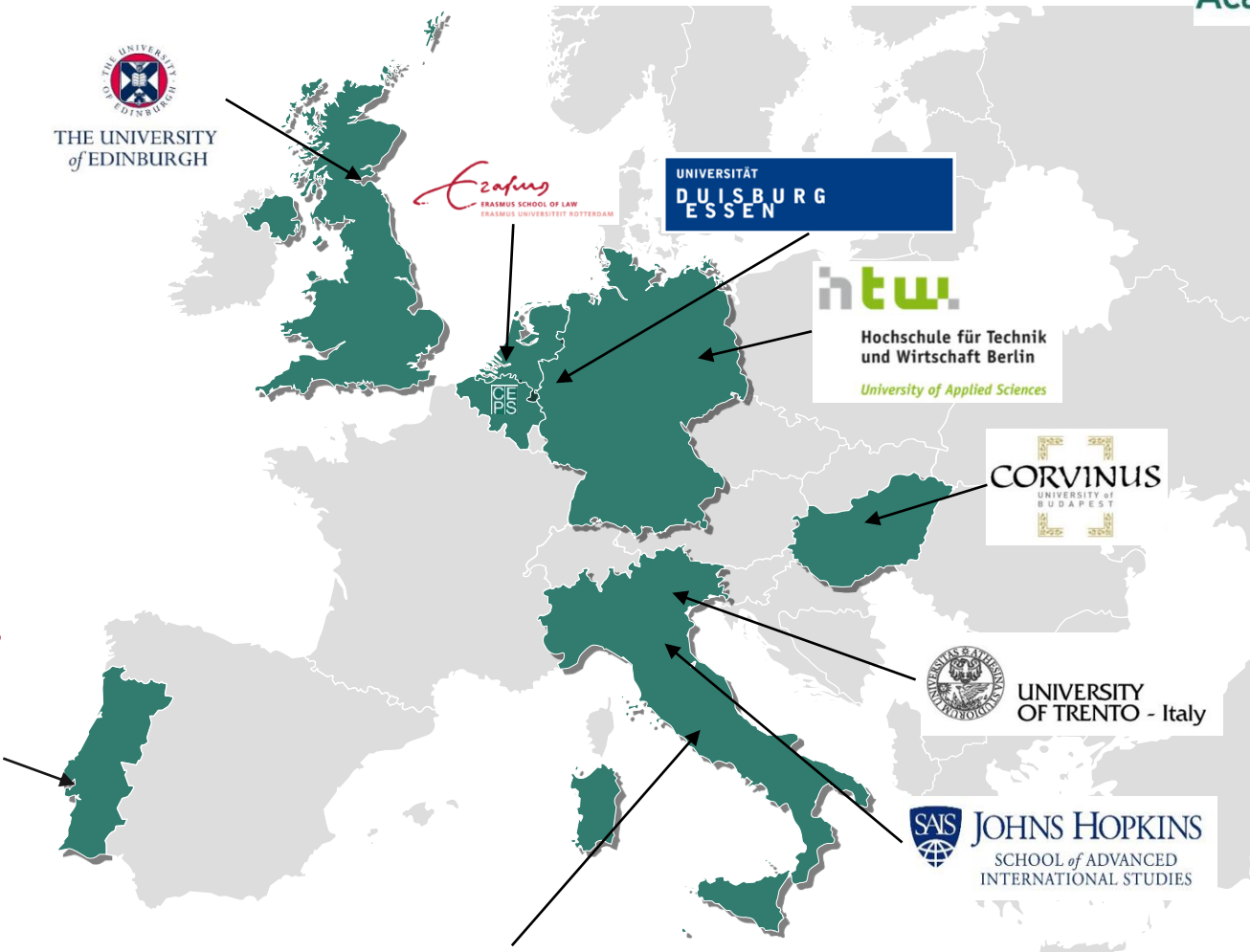

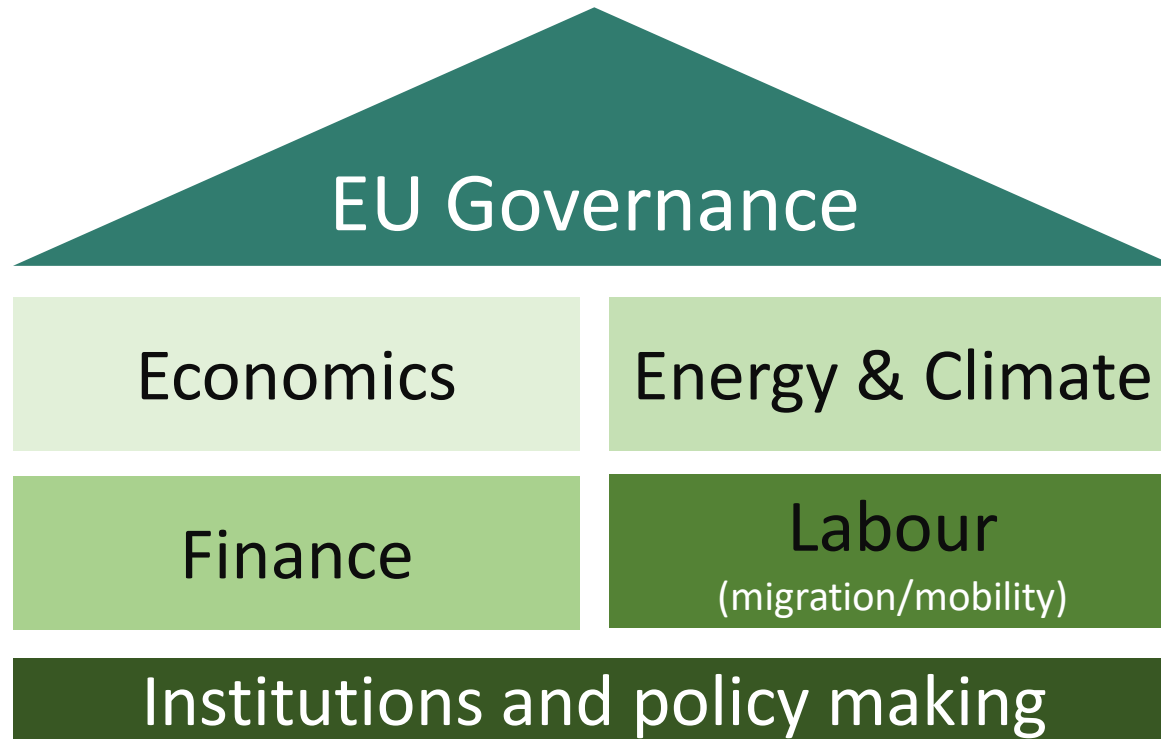

# Programme

- Seven weeks from 4 June to 20 July 2018 (not final yet)

- Final evaluation: short essay + participation in the interactive sessions
